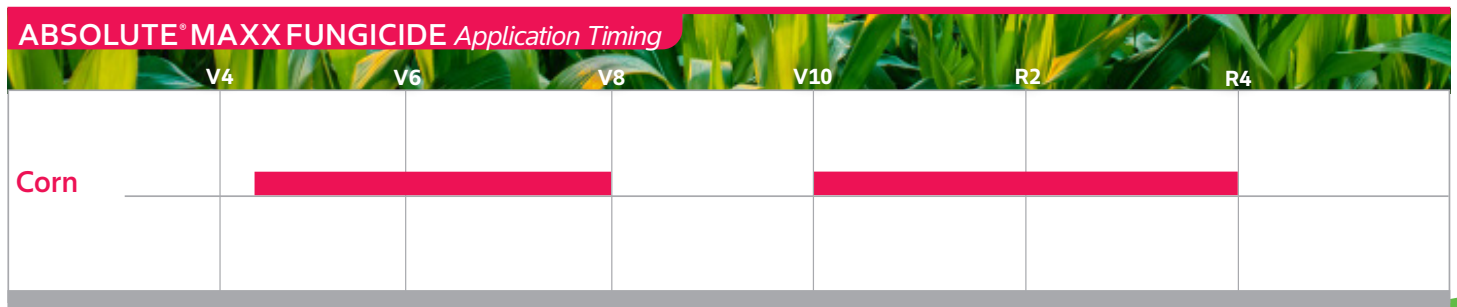

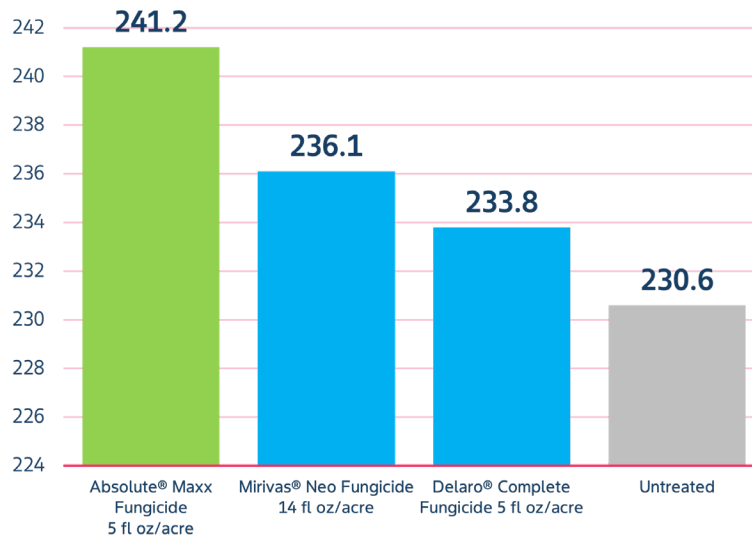

Early Corn Fungicide Comparison

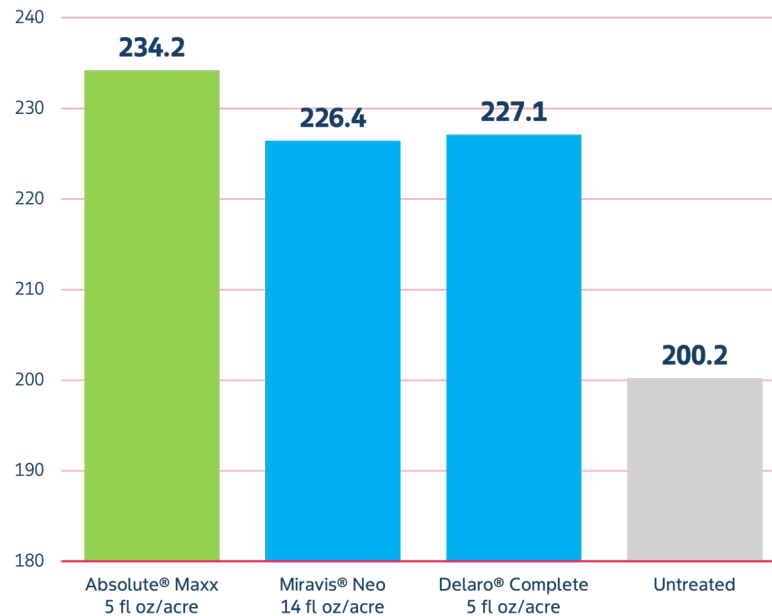
