**For the Tank Mix Application of DELARO 325 SC + PROLINE 480 SC Fungicides
for Suppression of Fusarium and Gibberella Ear Rot on
Field Corn, Field Corn Grown for Seed, and Popcorn**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.
- Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements, and precautions on this 2(ee) recommendation and the EPA registered label for DELARO 325 SC Fungicide and PROLINE 480 SC Fungicide.

Apply DELARO 325 SC + PROLINE 480 SC Fungicides at the following rates to suppress fusarium and Gibberella ear rot on field corn, field corn grown for seed, and popcorn:

Rate of DELARO 325 SC Fungicide	Rate of PROLINE 480 SC Fungicide
8 fl oz/A (0.093 lbs ai/A prothioconazole) (0.079 lbs ai/A trifloxystrobin)	2.72 fl oz/A (0.085 lbs ai/A prothioconazole)
10 fl oz/A (0.116 lbs ai/A prothioconazole) (0.099 lbs ai/A trifloxystrobin)	1.98 fl oz/A (0.062 lbs ai/A prothioconazole)
12 fl oz/A (0.139 lbs ai/A prothioconazole) (0.119 lbs ai/A trifloxystrobin)	1.22 fl oz/A (0.038 lbs ai/A prothioconazole)

For optimum suppression of fusarium and Gibberella ear rot, apply **DELARO 325 SC + PROLINE 480 SC Fungicides** from R1 (initial silk emergence) to the R2 (brown silk) corn growth stages. This combination will reduce both disease symptoms and levels of mycotoxin in the grain.

RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Maximum single application rate: 12.0 fl oz/acre of DELARO 325 SC Fungicide (0.139 lb/acre prothioconazole and 0.119 lb/acre trifloxystrobin).
- **DO NOT** apply more than 24.0 fl oz of DELARO 325 SC Fungicide (0.278 lb/acre prothioconazole and 0.238 lb/acre trifloxystrobin) per acre per year.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 22.8 fl oz of PROLINE 480 SC Fungicide (0.713 lbs prothioconazole) per acre of per year.
- **DO NOT** use handheld application equipment, including mechanically pressurized spray gun, backpack or tank pressurized spray gun or handheld boom applicators.
- Maximum number of applications: 2
- Pre-Harvest Interval (PHI): **14 day(s)** for grain and fodder. Forage may be harvested the same day of application.
- Application of DELARO 325 SC + PROLINE 480 SC Fungicides as a tank mixture is not recommended at times when corn is under severe environmental stress conditions.
- Minimum application volumes: 10 gallons/Acre (Ground); 2 gallons/Acre (Aerial)
- Regardless of formulation or method of application, **DO NOT** exceed 0.713 lbs prothioconazole, or 0.238 lbs trifloxystrobin per acre per year from all uses, including seed treatment, soil and foliar applications.
- To limit the potential for development of disease resistance to this fungicide, **DO NOT** make more than 2 sequential applications of DELARO 325 SC Fungicide or any Group 11 containing fungicide before rotating with a fungicide from a different Group.
